

24/7 SOBRIETY PROGRAM BREATH TESTING REQUIREMENTS

1. The Defendant shall submit to testing in the form of twice daily Alcohol Breath tests, and pay for the tests at the rate of \$1.00 per test. Payment shall be by cash or money order. No personal or two party checks will be accepted.
2. The Defendant shall report to the Cass County Jail at 450 34th St. S Fargo, ND within the next twenty four hours for registration into the Sobriety Program. The Defendant shall report every day thereafter between 7:15a.m. and 8:15a.m., and between 7:15p.m. and 8:15p.m. to the said Cass County Jail to submit to breath testing for detection of the consumption of alcoholic beverages.
3. The Defendant shall not use or possess any controlled substances or consume, use or possess any alcohol in any form.
4. The Defendant shall not consume or use any of the following items for a period of at least fifteen (15) minutes before Alcohol Breath testing: Mouthwash, toothpaste, cough syrup, carbonated beverages, food and tobacco products.
5. If at any time the Defendant fails to report for or submit to a test, or if the Defendant otherwise violates any of the conditions of the Court's Bond Order, to include the use of any controlled substance or should any amount of alcohol be indicated by an Alcohol Breath test, the Defendant may be detained and immediately taken into custody. The bond will then be set at the full amount that was previously determined by the court. If the defendant cannot post bond he/she will remain in custody until his/hers next scheduled court date or the defendant may also request a hearing either to contest whether a violation of the program occurred or to amend the conditions of bail.
6. At the discretion of the Sheriff's Office the defendant may be subject to electronic monitoring instead of or in-lieu of portable breath testing (PBT).
7. If ordered to the drug patch program the Defendant will agree to contact the Cass County Jail at 701-271-2911 to set up the program. The Defendant agrees to pay the cost of \$50.00 per patch test. The patch will need to be replaced at a minimum of every 14 days. While on the patch the Defendant will take responsibility to make sure the patch stays on, is not tampered with and will refrain from all illegal drug use. Patches may need to be changed out earlier than the fourteen days depending on the person and environment that it is worn in.
