HOW TO VOTE IN THE GENERAL ELECTION

VOTE ABSENTEE



You can request an absentee ballot for the General Election at the address below!

vote.nd.gov ▶ “Vote by Mail/Absentee”

Or you can fill out the reverse side of this flyer and mail it in or drop it off at the courthouse dropbox.

NOTE: Absentee ballots will not be available until September 24th. Absentee ballots, for those that have applied, will arrive in mailboxes in the first or second week of October.

VOTE ON ELECTION DAY

Cass County voters can use any of the Early Voting sites in metro Cass County or Casselton to cast their votes for the General Election on November 3.

If you have moved since the last time you voted, you should make sure your address with the ND Department of Transportation is current and accurate. You can update your address online by visiting vote.nd.gov. You do not need to get a new physical license or ID card.



We are committed to providing options for voters and to keep both our voters and our election workers safe during the General Election.



For the safety of everyone involved in the election, we encourage masks to be worn at all polling places.

VOTE EARLY

Voting early is convenient and simple.

Cass County voters can use any of the Early Voting sites listed in the schedule below.

You will be able to vote at multiple locations in the metro area and in Casselton fifteen days prior to Election Day. This is an effort to provide opportunities to cast ballots in person while at the same time offering enough hours to keep people socially distanced as much as possible while exercising their right to vote.
